GJ slowdown to impact SMEs severely



Revenue growth in the gems and jewellery industry is expected to slow down this fiscal year, with export demand falling for the second consecutive year due to a slowdown in key markets even as domestic demand remains positive. Small and medium enterprises (SMEs), which contribute almost 70 per cent of the industry revenue, had logged robust growth in revenue and profit in fiscal year 2022 due to the release of pent-up demand and resumption of large-scale weddings and festivities after two pandemic-hit years.

In fiscal year 2023, while financial information of SMEs is yet to flow in, we estimate the revenue of domestic players to have slowed down following an increase in gold prices and that of exporters to have fallen due to a drop in demand for cut and polished diamonds.

In fiscal year 2024, exports of cut and polished diamonds, which constitute over 60 per cent of India's gems and jewellery exports, are set to fall for the second consecutive year after declining 10 per cent in dollar terms in fiscal year 2023 and by almost a third during the first two months of the current fiscal year.

Recessionary pressures in the US, which is the largest market for cut and polished diamonds, are likely to impact demand and, in turn, revenue and profitability. SMEs in this industry are more susceptible to fluctuations in end-user demand and are expected to be impacted severely.

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



Violent events typically happen in two situations. One, where unskilled robbers use violence in the very early stages of the incident. And two, when robbers lose their temper and the incident ends with severe violence, due to individuals' defensive behavior in an attempt to fight over the goods and save them from being robbed.

We remind and recommend that robbers' instructions must be obeyed. No matter where an attack occurs - on the road, in the store or at offices. The merchant's role is to prevent the robbery, to detect tale signs of a coming attack, to understand at an early stage that an attack is about to take place, and in general - to always follow the rules of preventive behavior.

Nevertheless, if a robbery occurs, you should not try to prevent it; you should not try to resist; you should not try to "defeat" the robbers. Behave as calmly as possible and follow the instructions given by the attackers - any attempt to fight back may make the incident more violent.

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



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
PM to inaugurate Surat Diamond Bourse in December 2023

US blocks US\$26m of India diamond payments to Russia

Offshore subsidiaries of Indian diamond merchants have had fund transfers worth almost \$26m frozen after US authorities claimed the rough diamonds were mined in Russia. The Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) singled out UAE subsidiaries of Indian jewellers it claims have connected suppliers with Russian investors.



OFAC is said to have instructed banks in recent months to halt the transfer of funds, mostly from UAE subsidiaries of Indian companies.

GJEPC is lobbying the Indian Ministry of Commerce and the Indian embassy in the UAE to resolve matters.

Vipul Shah, chairman - GJEPC, told Economic Times: "We are trying to explain to OFAC that the payments were made to non-sanctioned entities and even to some Russian entities well before the sanctions came into place. There is very little direct import of diamonds from Russia."

Neither India nor the UAE has sanctioned rough diamonds from Russia.Leaders of the G7 nations concluded their summit in Hiroshima, Japan, in May without the clear mandate to fully sanction Russian diamonds that many had expected.

Fancy-color diamonds index continues ascent



The average price of fancy-color diamonds continued to climb in all categories in the second quarter, led by a resurgence in demand for large fancy-vivid yellows, according to the Fancy Color Research Foundation (FCRF).

The group's Fancy Color Diamond Index gained 0.5% compared with the previous three months, it reported last week.

The increase was seen in nearly all colors and sizes. The highest rise for the second quarter was in the fancy-vivid grade at 1.2%. The other two saturation categories, fancy and fancy intense, showed a combined improvement below 0.3%. Yellows posted a notable jump of 1.3%, while pinks and blues increased by 0.2%.

The strongest categories in the second quarter were 8-carat, fancy-vivid-yellow diamonds, which spiked by 5.4%, followed by 1.5-carat vivid pinks, which grew 3.2%. Vivid pinks weighing 1 carat advanced 3.1%.

Lucara recovers 1,080.1 ct diamond from Karowe, in Botswana



It's the fourth +1,000-ct stone from Karowe, in Botswana, since the mine opened in 2012. The Type IIa top white gem quality diamond measures 82.2m x 42.8m x 34.2mm and was recovered from direct milling of ore sourced from the mine's South Lobe.

Eira Thomas, CEO of the Canadian miner, said the company was "extremely pleased" to be reporting the recovery of another large, high-quality gem, and was hopeful its underground expansion plan (costing \$683m) would yield even more. She said: As we progress mining deeper in the open pit and transition to underground mining, exclusively in the South Lobe, the preponderance of large, high value stones is increasing, consistent with the resource model and underpins the strong economic rationale for investing in the underground expansion that will extend the mine-life out to at least 2040."

LGD biggest threat to Namibian diamond industry



Lab grown diamonds are the biggest threat facing the Namibian diamond industry, Namib Desert Diamonds (Namdia)'s Lelly Usiku, Executive: Market Development, Sales and Brand has disclosed.


Usiku said lab diamonds or synthetic diamonds cost about 60 to 80 less than natural diamonds like the ones

produced by Namibia.e noted that synthetic diamonds are growing in popularity in China, which is the biggest retail market in the world after the United States.

The other factors threatening the industry are the Russia-Ukraine Crisis, which is affecting the production at Russian producer, Alrosa. The other factors threatening the stability of the industry according to Usiku are poor performance of the US economy with high inflation and interest rates
