Violence during robbery incidents is increasing everywhere, in stores, against sales agents on the roads and at various exhibition events. Recently, a secured courier company employee was murdered, a jeweler was murdered in Houston, and others were injured in various robbery incidents.

Violent events typically happen in two situations. One, where unskilled robbers use violence in the very early stages of the incident. And two, when robbers lose their temper and the incident ends with severe violence, due to individuals' defensive behavior in an attempt to fight over the goods and save them from being robbed.

We remind and recommend that robbers' instructions must be obeyed. No matter where an attack occurs - on the road, in the store or at offices. The merchant's role is to prevent the robbery, to detect tale signs of a coming attack, to understand at an early stage that an attack is about to take place, and in general - to always follow the rules of preventive behavior.

Nevertheless, if a robbery occurs, you should not try to prevent it; you should not try to resist; you should not try to "defeat" the robbers. Behave as calmly as possible and follow the instructions given by the attackers - any attempt to fight back may make the incident more violent.




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


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GGJS - 2023 ends on a positive note


Day 2 saw two panel discussion. The first was titled "J20 - YOUNG JEWELERS SUMMIT".





Consumers likely to exchange old gold for new as prices surge



The escalating conflict between Israel and Palestine has led to an increase in gold prices, prompting Indian consumers to sell their gold holdings in order to take advantage of the spike. Industry executives predict that gold prices could rise further if the conflict deepens. Gold prices set to rise: The ongoing conflict between Israel and Palestine has led to a surge in gold prices in India. Consumers are expected to sell their gold holdings to take advantage of the spike in prices ahead of the festival season.

Gold prices in India have already risen by Rs 874 per 10 gm, reaching Rs 57,415/10 gm, following an attack by the Palestinian group Hamas on Israel over the weekend. Industry insiders predict that prices could rise even further by Rs 2,500-3,000 per 10 gm if the conflict escalates in West Asia.

Jewellers such as Senco Gold & Diamonds and Tanishq have reported a significant increase in their gold exchange business as consumers opt to exchange their old gold jewellery for new ornaments.

LGDs will shine brighter this festive season

LGDs will shine brighter this festive season. Price remains a key magnet for customers, to be sure, as a carat of lab-grown diamond (LGD) costs ₹60,000-70,000, a fraction of ₹10-11 lakh for a natural diamond.

Even high-net-worth individuals (HNIs) have taken a shine to lab-grown diamonds, which earlier attracted mainly the 18-35 age group that could not afford natural diamonds, said people in the know. This, they said, has prompted listed players like Senco Gold & Diamonds to enter the market in this financial year to tap into the growing demand. Price remains a key magnet for customers, to be sure, as a carat of lab-grown diamond (LGD) costs ₹60,000-70,000, a fraction of ₹10-11 lakh for a natural diamond. "With increased awareness

and consumer acceptance of LGD jewellery in India, we are extremely bullish this Diwali season and expecting sales growth of almost 60% year-on-year," said Mumbai-based Pooja Sheth Madhavan, founder of Limelight Lab Grown Diamonds.

Sarine launches Melee-Diamond Tracking Program

Sarine Technologies has unveiled a new system that traces the origins of melee diamonds and establishes a link between the rough and polished.

The system — which Sarine created in partnership with French jeweler Rubel & Ménasché — measures the diamonds in the rough stage and follows them through the cutting and polishing phases, the Israel-based company said.

Sarine first uses its Autoscan Plus system to register parcels with large quantities of diamonds, then carries out planning and quality-control measurements throughout the manufacturing process, it explained. The company ran a pilot with one of Rubel & Ménasché's melee suppliers, testing the solution's feasibility across various diamond types and cutting processes. The pilot confirmed that the system could cost-effectively trace large quantities of melee, Sarine reported.

Gold's role as safe haven underscored by Israel Hamas war

Gold's historical role as a safe haven re-emphasized amid escalating Israel-Hamas conflict, driving a potential shift in its price trajectory.

Five outlined scenarios shed light on the myriad factors poised to influence gold prices in the near term. Escalation of Conflict, Resolution or De-escalation, Continued Strong U.S. Economic Data, Fed Interest Rate Hike, Market Sentiment Shift.



The escalation might also pose threats to oil supplies or trigger broader market sell-offs, further propelling gold prices upward. The magnitude of the conflict and the responses from global powers could exacerbate or mitigate the influence on gold prices, underscoring a multifaceted interplay of global financial and geopolitical dynamics.

GIA traceability to help with G7 sanctions compliance

Gemological Institute of America (GIA) has said it supports all workable solutions to meet the rising consumer and government demand for credible country-of-origin data for polished diamonds. Working with the Gem and Jewellery Export Council (GJEPC) of India, the World Diamond Council (WDC), the Antwerp World Diamond Centre (AWDC) and others in



the industry, GIA is supporting the development of effective diamond traceability solutions. This multilateral cooperation is especially important as the segregation of diamonds by origin is necessary as the Group of Seven (G7) countries are expected to announce stronger sanctions and enforcement policies to ensure that Russian origin diamonds do not enter the G7 nations, likely to be effective early in 2024.

GIA has two diamond origin services – the GIA Diamond Origin Report, introduced in 2019, and the GIA Source Verification Service, launched in 2022. Each service uses verified, audited documents including Kimberley Process certificates to confirm country-of-origin information provided by mining companies and link that information to diamonds submitted to GIA for grading.

South Korea's KDT to set up LGD factory in Surat



South Korea-based lab-grown diamond manufacturer KDT Diamonds has received approval from the Indian Ministry of Commerce & Industry to establish a lab-grown diamond manufacturing and polishing plant in Surat. This move marks a strategic expansion for KDT Diamonds and sets the stage for a major boost in lab-grown diamond production.

Construction of the factory, measuring 2,000 square metres in the Surat Special Economic Zone, is scheduled to commence in November 2023, with completion anticipated by March 2024. The company expects to produce 36,000 carats of lab-grown diamonds in its maiden year of operation, with plans to scale up to an impressive 100,000 carats annually in the near future.

To support its operations, KDT Diamonds will establish a local subsidiary in India and hire approximately 150 skilled professionals. Currently, KDT Diamond stands as South Korea's sole lab-grown diamond production company. Earlier this year, the company secured a patent for a "microwave plasma CVD device for diamond synthesis."



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
